FUND 40 - SPECIAL RESERVE FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide you information regarding Sweetwater Union High School District Fund 40.

Fund 40 is a governmental fund of the district formally titled Special Reserve for Capital Projects. The fund was established by the Board of Trustees in resolution number 1306 on June 29, 1978, (see attached) and has existed as a fund of the district since that date.

The fund exists to provide accumulation of general fund monies for capital outlay purposes. The revenue stream for the fund is primarily redevelopment funds and rental income from the L Street property, earmarked for asset utilization purposes and Proposition 39 (Clean Energy Jobs Act) for those projects fulfilling Proposition 39 criteria.

On motion of Member Chapman, seconded by Member Wood, the following resolution is adopted:

WHEREAS, the Education Code authorizes school districts to transfer funds from one fund to another; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Sweetwater Union High School District desires to authorize the transfer of funds from the General Fund to the Building Fund or Special Reserve Fund, as appropriate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sweetwater Union High School District hereby authorizes the Superintendent of Schools, Auditor, and Treasurer of San Diego County to transfer \$1,100,000 from the General Fund of said school district to the Building Fund or Special Reserve Fund of said district, as specified by the District Superintendent.
